English curriculum - learning covers the following areas:

- * Spelling
- *Grammar and punctuation
- *Reading
- *Writing
- *Speaking and Listening



Important Elements of Year 5 and 6: Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

- * Work in appropriate groups within the class over the year - embedded into the T4W (Talk for Writing) approach
- * Spelling rule/pattern/words or follow-up work will be sent home to reinforce and extend learning.
- * Focus on understanding and using the rule/pattern in written work – there is a weekly spelling test. The children need to be spelling the words in their written work.



Reading at school and home

- * Guided reading
- * Class book
- * Quiet reading
- * Library
- * Home reading



Maths

- 5 lessons a week based on the White Rose Maths scheme
- * Set across Years 5 and 6
- * This enables us to target more specifically and effectively children's needs
- * Movement across groups is possible



Practising and Reinforcing tables

- * We are using TT Rockstars across Years 5 and 6 to practise times tables (other platforms may be used in addition).
- * A fun and engaging way for children to improve their knowledge and accuracy of tables
- * Can be used on tablets, smart phones and PCs


